

#### March 6, 2024

This milestone event established the Foundation's unique identity, reinforcing its mandate to mobilize philanthropic funding in support of the University of Namibia.



#### April 11, 2024

#### Partnerships Making Dreams a Reality

Loise Shipepe and Araricky Shikongo, recent UNAM graduates, exemplify the impact of philanthropy in higher education. With bursary support from Namibia Asset Management and Oranjemund Angling Club, managed by the UNAM Foundation, Loise completed her Bachelor of Accountancy, and Araricky earned his Master of Science in Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences. Their achievements underscore the powerful role of giving in shaping future leaders.







#### May 07, 2024

#### **Partnerships fostering Job Readiness**

Old Mutual, alongside UNAM Foundation, enhanced students' employability and financial literacy skills.

Over 200 students participated in a workshop on budgeting, professional etiquette, CV writing, and interview skills, connecting academic knowledge with practical job skills.

May 14, 2024

Deloitte, in partnership with the UNAM Foundation and UNAM's SRC, hosted a one-day employment readiness workshop at UNAM's Main, Neudamm, and Khomasdal Campuses. Skills covered: CV writing, interview tips, personal branding, and financial basics like budgeting and taxes.



#### May 17, 2024

#### Corporate Bursaries

In May, Namibia Asset Management generously donated over N\$216,890 to the UNAM Foundation, providing support for four students.

The Foundation also received commitments from the De Beers Group, M&G Investments, and DP World, furthering its mission to empower future Namibian professionals.



October 19, 2024

#### Inaugural Chancellor's Annual Charity Gala Dinner









The University of Namibia Foundation raised over N\$700,000 at its Chancellor's Annual Charity Gala Dinner, held on October 19, 2024. The event aimed to support underprivileged students and those in the "missing middle," addressing critical needs such as tuition, transportation, and food. Attended by key stakeholders, the gala underscored the Foundation's vital role in empowering students and ensuring access to education.

At the event, UNAM Vice Chancellor Professor Kenneth Matengu revealed that students collectively owe the university over N\$300 million, with N\$184 million attributed to current students. He highlighted that the gala fundraising event is part of UNAM's continued efforts to alleviate this financial burden and support students in pursuing their education.

In remarks delivered on his behalf by Honorable Christine Hoebes, President Dr. Nangolo Mbumba underscored the significance of the UNAM Foundation in complementing government initiatives, including NSFAF, Petrofund, SSC, NTA, and others.

The evening's programme included inspiring speeches from three former UNAM Foundation beneficiaries who have become prominent contributors to Namibia's economy: Ms. Ainna Kaundu, Acting CEO of BIPA and UNAM Foundation Trustee; Mr. Tega Shiimi ya Shiimi, CEO of Sanlam Investments Namibia; and Mr. Gabriel Haufiku, Audit Manager at Deloitte & Touche Namibia.

In her address, Executive Director Ms. Bernadette Bock encouraged UNAM alumni to maintain strong ties with the university, emphasizing the importance of nurturing the personal bonds and memories formed during their time at UNAM. She highlighted the critical role graduates play in advancing Namibia's development across various sectors and called on alumni to contribute to the university in meaningful ways, both personally and professionally. Ms. Bock accentuated that alumni are instrumental in supporting current students and ensuring UNAM's long-term sustainability.

Among the contributions, FirstRand Namibia pledged the largest donation of N\$500,000, dedicated to enhancing inclusivity within the educational environment at the library of UNAM's main campus.



### PROGRAMS UPDATE

Aligned with the Namibian Government's vision to expand access to quality tertiary education, the UNAM Foundation proudly reaffirms its commitment to managing a two-pronged Bursary Programme. This initiative focuses on maximizing the impact of funds raised to support dedicated students and enhance access to higher education for Namibian youth.

#### BURSARY FUNDS

The UNAM Foundation's Bursary Programme offers two key avenues for educational support:

#### **CORPORATE BURSARY FUNDS:**

Corporates can establish bursary funds with naming rights, which the Foundation manages aligned with corporate values. With 20+ years of experience, we manage the entire bursary process, from fund structuring to reporting and student engagement. Students from any local and international recognised tertiary education institution can be supported. In 2024, 13 students received partial and full bursaries through this initiative.

#### **UNAM STUDENTS' FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FUND:**

The Foundation provides one-time financial aid to UNAM students facing financial challenges. Covering tuition, accommodation, learning materials, and unforeseen emergencies, this Fund supported 10 students across 12 campuses in 2024.

Many recipients noted they would have struggled to continue their studies without this support.



"Your support has transformed my education and my family's circumstances. Before receiving this bursary, my mother, as a single parent, was under significant financial stress, struggling to cover my tuition and accommodation fees with some help from my aunt. #### FirstRand Namibia Supports Differently-Abled Students with a N\$500,000 Investment



FirstRand Namibia, through its foundation, has made a significant contribution towards empowering differently-abled students at the University of Namibia (UNAM) in the form of a N\$500,000 investment towards enhancing the library facilities for visually impaired students.

This project focuses on equipping a dedicated study lounge with modern technologies, including enlarged screens, specialized keyboards, and Braille machines. These upgrades will make it easier for visually impaired students to access learning materials and fully participate in their academic pursuits.

During the handover ceremony, Ms. Revonia Job, Group Corporate Social Investment Manager, emphasized FirstRand Namibia's commitment to advancing inclusivity and improving access to education for all. She highlighted the significance of creating equal opportunities for students with disabilities to achieve success in their academic pursuits.




MARKETING INTERN
